The territory of [Romanian-ruled Transnistria](#) (1941-44, 42,000 km²/16,216 sq mi) is incongruent with and included [present-day Transnistria](#) (4,163 km²/1,607 sq mi).

1. The 1941-1944 Transnistria Governorate (Romanian: *Guvernământul Transnistriei*) was a Romanian-ruled territory between the Rivers Dniestr and Bug, occupied from 19 August 1941 to 29 January 1944; it was used by Romania as the main killing field for the extermination of Romanian and Ukrainian Jews.

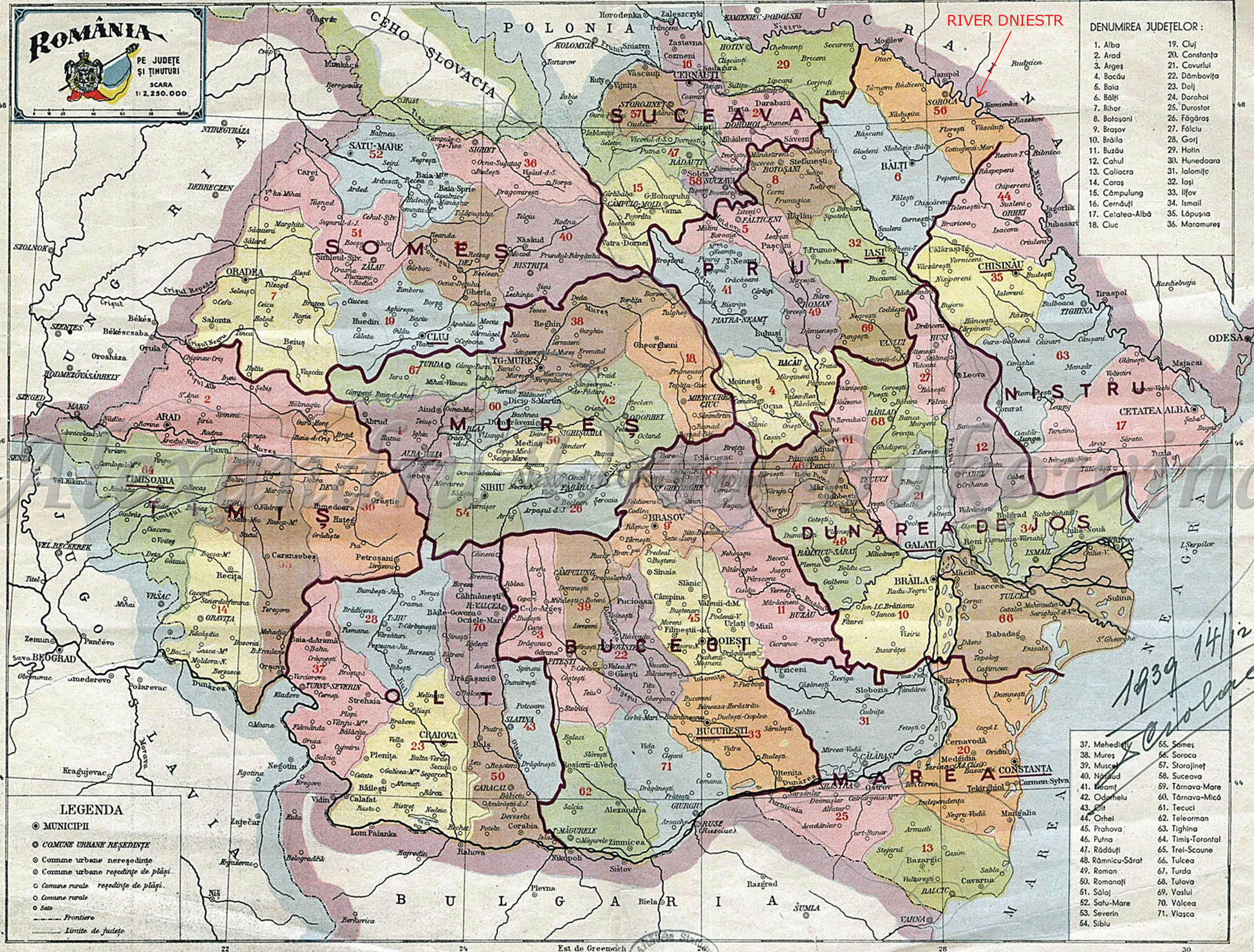

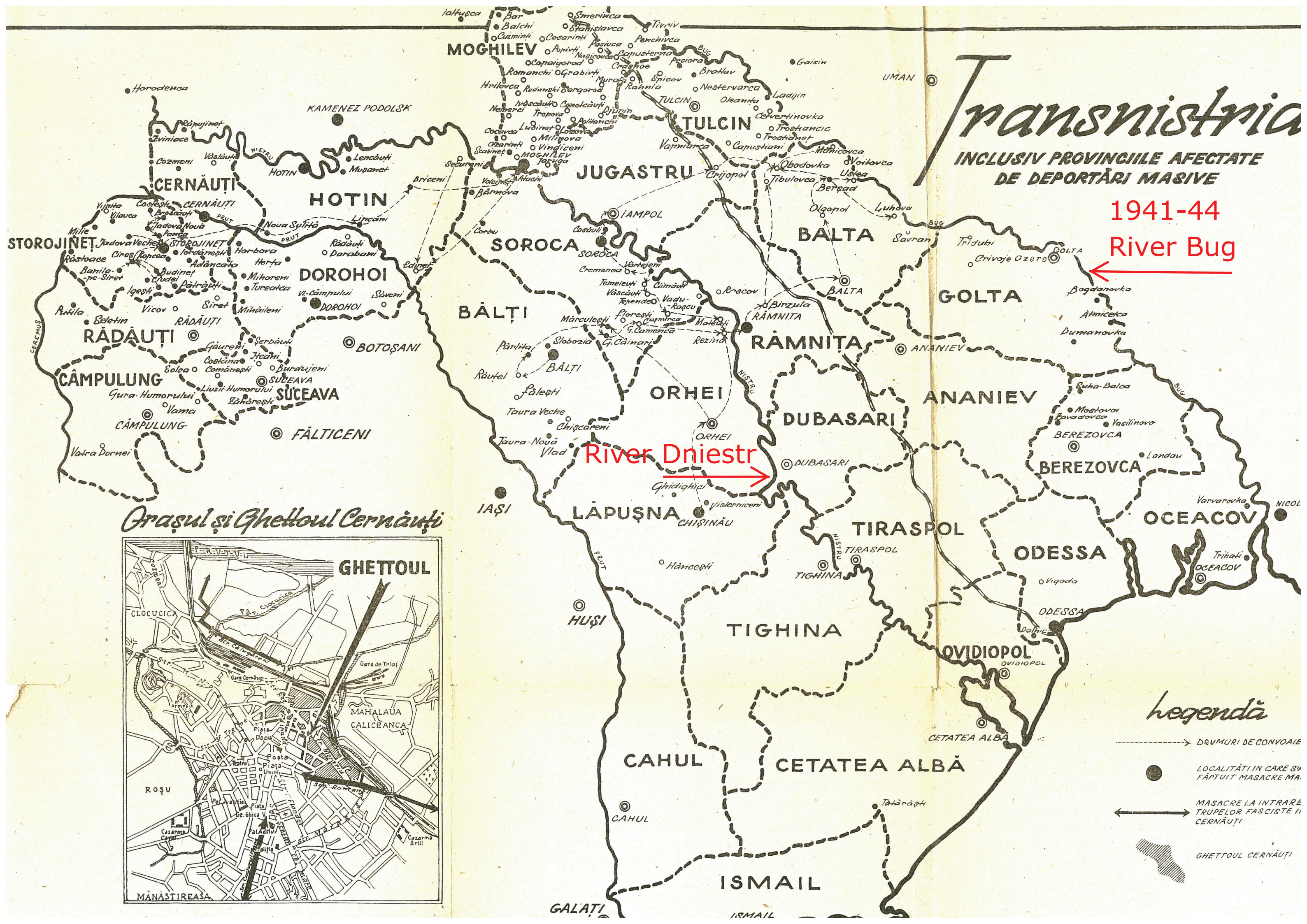

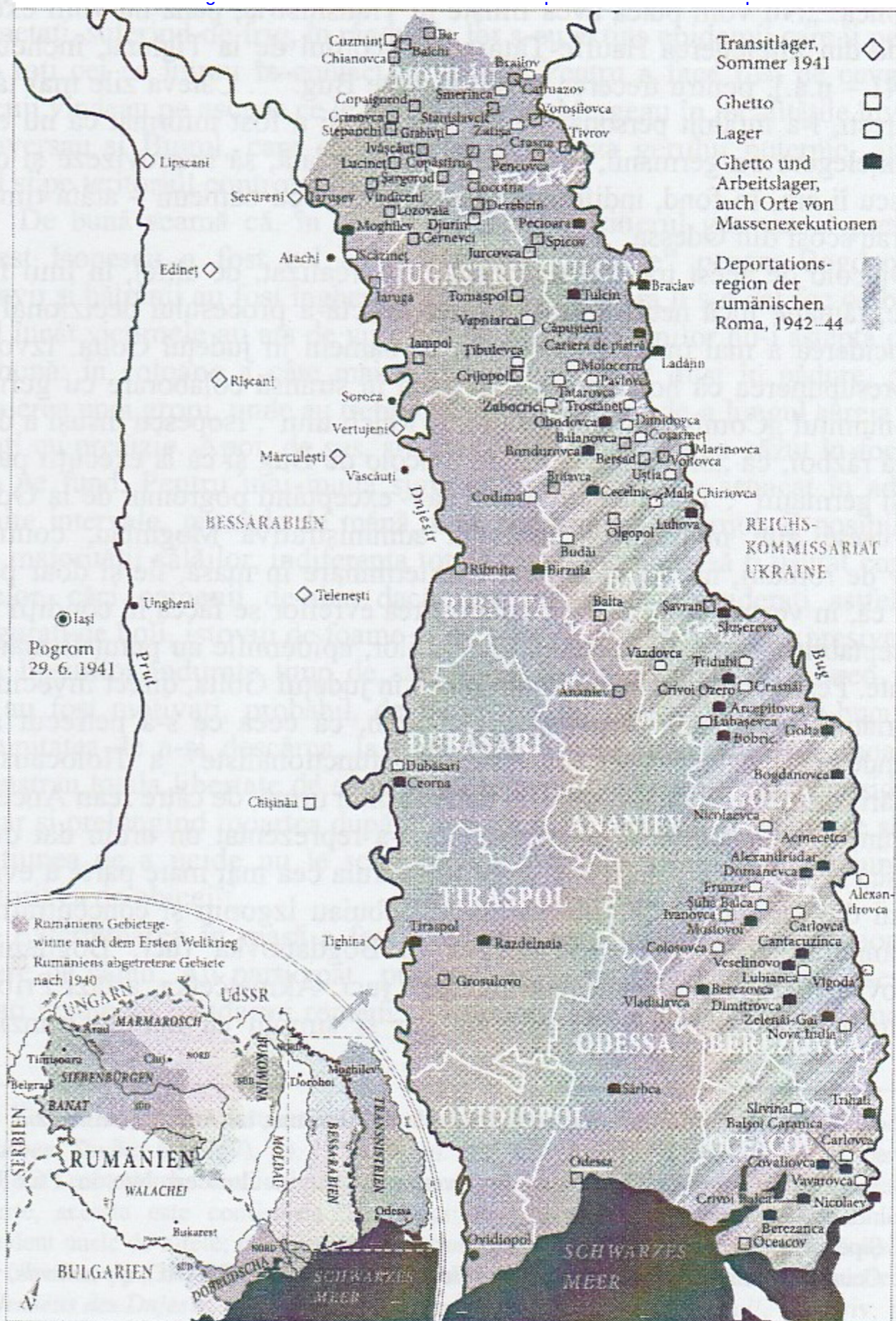

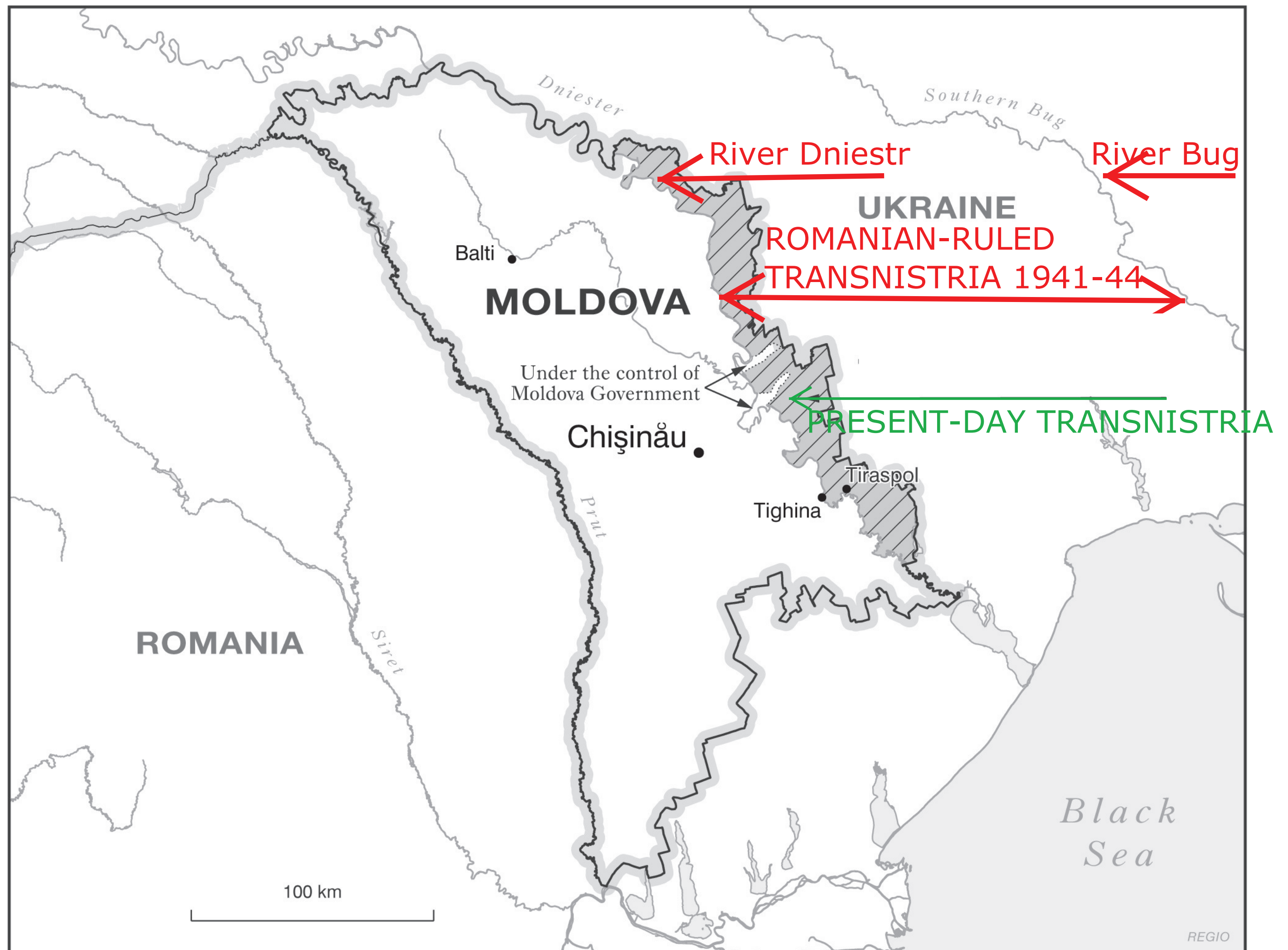
Map of Romanian controlled Transnistria 1941-1944
with main ghettos and concentration camps

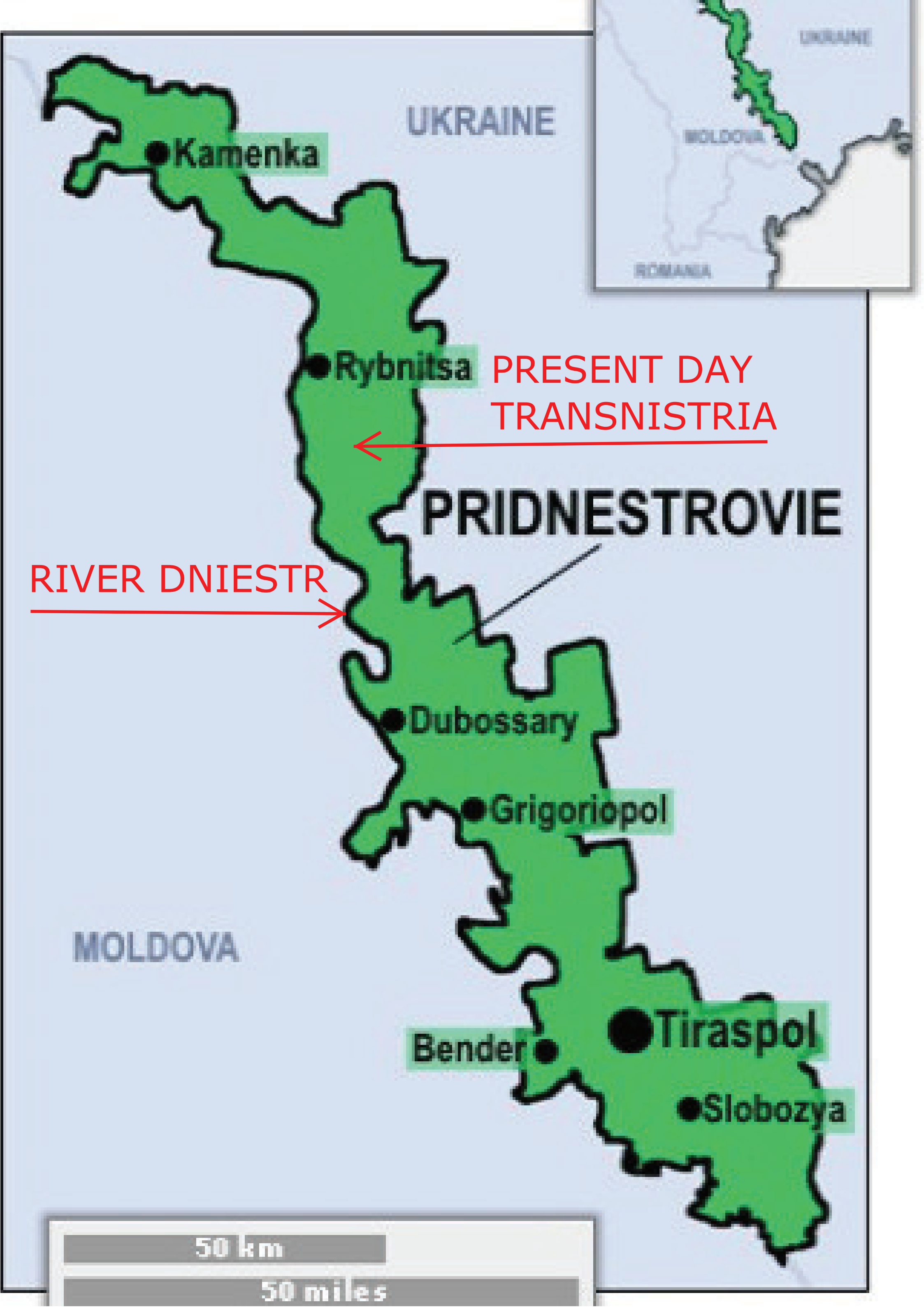
